3	In this video I'll show you how to use
4	Lang-8.
5	
6	First, click on "Learn for Free!" Type
7	your e-mail address here and click on
8	"send." I recommend that you use an e-mail
9	address that you can use on a personal
10	computer. I think you should avoid using a
11	mobile phone e-mail address unless you
12	have a smart phone that lets you view
13	ordinary web pages. Soon after you send
14	your e-mail address, Lang-8 will send an e-
15	mail to you. Open the e-mail and click on
16	the address. If you cannot click on the
17	address, copy it and then paste it into your
18	internet browser. If you cannot read the
19	Japanese in the e-mail from Lang-8, don't
20	worry. Just copy the address you see and
21	paste it into your browser.
22	
23	Now you can type in your profile. If
24	you want to, you can change the interface
25	language here. The "nickname" is the name
26	that people will see on the internet. It can
27	be part of your real name or any name you
28	choose. Please type your nickname in
29	English letters, not Japanese. Choose the
30	year you were born, your native language,
31	your home country, your gender, and the
32	language your are studying. If you are
33	watching this video in Japan, choose Japan
34 35	here and change the time zone to Tokyo. You can choose any combination of letters
36	and numbers you like to make your
37	password. Make a note of your password
38	and be sure not to loose it. You can adjust
38 39	your privacy settings here and then finish
40	the registration process by clicking this
40	button.

43 Now that you have a Lang-8 account, 44 you can write something in English about 45 yourself. Click on "write" and type a 46 message. Please don't copy the expressions you see on the screen. Write your own 47 unique message. In this class, it is very 48 important that your message be open to all 49 50 internet users. 51

52 After you have written your first 53 message, send me the address of your Lang-54 8 page in an e-mail. First, click on your nickname. Then, copy the address in your 55 browser. In a new e-mail, type my e-mail 56 address in the "To" line, your own name 57 58 (not the letters you see on this screen) in the 59 subject line, and paste the address in the 60 body of the e-mail. Then, click on "send." 61

62 Lang-8 is a site where people can help 63 each other learn. If you want other people 64 to help you, you should make friends by helping other people. To do this, click on 65 "Lang-8" and then click on "Entries awaiting 66 your corrections." I'll look at this one to see 67 if I can help him. This " $\mathcal{O}$ " should not be 68 here. "所在ない" seems a little strange here. 69 I'll change that to 退屈をしていました。Now, 70 71 I'll type a personal message to him and then click this button. I see that I forgot to type 72 73 the kanji for 退屈 so I'll click "correct"and 74 fix my mistake. 75

76 If you correct the entries of people you
77 meet on Lang-8, I'm sure that some of them
78 will help you. After someone corrects
79 something you have written be sure to thank
80 the person and look at what they have
81 written to see if you can help them.
